



## The Instrument of Government of Wimbledon College

- 1 The name of the school is *Wimbledon College*.
- 2 The school is a voluntary aided school.
- 3 The name of the governing body is *The Governing Body of Wimbledon College*.
- 4 The governing body shall consist of:
  - a. four parent governors
  - b. two Local Education Authority governors
  - c. three staff governors (including the Head Teacher, a member of the teaching staff, and a member of the support staff)
  - d. eleven foundation governors (of whom three shall be eligible as parent governors)
- 5 The total number of governors is twenty.
- 6 Wimbledon College is in the trusteeship of the Society of Jesus (registered as the *Trustees for Roman Catholic Purposes*).
- 7 The Trustees for Roman Catholic Purposes are entitled to appoint foundation governors.
- 8 Wimbledon College is a Roman Catholic school in the Jesuit tradition. As a Jesuit school it is founded for *improvement in living and learning to the greater glory of God and the common good*. Religious education and worship is conducted according to the teaching and practice of the Roman Catholic church.
- 9 This instrument of government comes into effect on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2006
- 10 A copy of this instrument of government must be supplied to every member of the governing body and to the trustees.
- 11 This instrument of government has been adopted in accordance with the *School Governance (Constitution) (England) Regulations 2003*.
