Sixth Form Dress Code

Sixth Form pupils are expected to follow the Sixth Form dress code. Dress and appearance are to be in keeping with the formality of school life.

- Sixth Form pupils are required to wear a **suit** or formal jacket and trousers.
- **Shirts** are to be formal, plain or striped in sober colours, tucked in and the top button done up.
- The Sixth Form **tie**, Prefect's tie or Colours tie is to be worn and be clearly visible.
- **Shoes** are to be formal and suitable for wearing with a suit or jacket and tie. Trainers and canvas shoes are not appropriate.
- **Hair** should be clean and tidy.
- Boys are to be **clean-shaven**.
- **Jewellery** is not to be worn.

Boys must follow the dress code on the way to and from school, as well as in school and at school functions.

Boys are to take notice of any rules given from time to time by the Deputy Head or Head of Sixth Form in relation to particular items of clothing or appearance.

Sixth Form pupils should not need to be constantly reminded about standards of dress and appearance and should set an example to younger pupils.

The final arbiter of what is or is not acceptable dress or appearance is the Head of Sixth Form.
