## FURTHER INFORMATION

### Music Tutors

Saturday Music School (SMS) tutors are self-employed. Wimbledon College provides the administration and venue for the Saturday Music School. It also ensures child protection checks have been properly carried out.

### Payment and Missed Lessons

The full course of 10 lessons is payable in advance. If a student is unable to attend a lesson, it still has to be paid for as we are unable to fill single slots for the teachers. It is sometimes possible to re-schedule a replacement lesson with the teacher concerned. Please keep the SMS Co-Ordinator informed if your child is likely to miss a lesson. Because many of the tutors are professional musicians with performance commitments, they may occasionally have to cancel a lesson. If this happens, a replacement lesson will be arranged or the lesson cost will be refunded.

### Online payment

## Saturday Music School

The Saturday Music School at Wimbledon College offers music tuition to adults and children of all ages.

Lessons are currently offered in Piano, Keyboard, Violin, Cello, Saxophone, Guitar, Drums, Djembe Drum and Voice. Where there is sufficient demand, tuition can be arranged in other instruments.

The Saturday Music School also offers a Young Musicians' Programme for 3-5 year olds.

### Individual Tuition

Individual tuition is available in the following instruments:

- Piano
- Drums
- Saxophone

- Keyboard

Other instruments can usually be arranged on request.

**Cost £165 per term**

(Ten 30-minute lessons = £16.50 per half hour)

### Group Tuition

Some children prefer to be taught in small groups. Group lessons should be considered as an introduction to the instrument. For individual progression it would be expected that children would eventually move on to individual lessons. Group tuition is currently available in Guitar and Keyboard for 30-minute lessons.

### Young Musicians' Programme

The Young Musicians' Programme for 3 to 5 year olds teaches basic singing, rhythmic and aural skills. Much like learning a language, the best way for children to learn music is to hear it from a young age. Our experienced tutor will introduce your child to the world of music through listening and movement. There are two sessions.

**Cost £65 per term**

Either 10.00- 10.30am or 12.30 - 1.00pm

(Ten 30-minute sessions = £6.50 per half hour)

### Jazz Ensemble

The Jazz Ensemble is a fun and interactive group allowing children to play in a band as well as individually. The tutor will teach Jazz standards, improvisation, band interaction and sight reading. Instruments: Saxophone, Trumpet, Trombone, Clarinet, Guitar, Piano, Bass guitar, Drums, and Percussion. Participants must have at least Grade 2 in their instrument.

**Cost £100 per term** Time: 3.00 - 4.00pm

(Ten 1-hour sessions = £10.00 per hour)

### End-of-Term Concert

At the end of the Autumn Term as a Christmas celebration, those children who wish to participate are invited to perform in an informal concert for their parents and families. The concert will take place on the Wimbledon College stage and gives children an opportunity to experience the focus and exhilaration of public performance in a supportive setting.

### Scratch Chorus

The Wimbledon College Scratch Chorus is an opportunity for adults and young people who enjoy singing but who do not have the time for long-term commitments to sing together. Six rehearsals on consecutive Mondays (7.30-9.15pm) followed by a concert for families and friends. The Scratch Chorus begins on the first Monday after the summer half term in the school hall.
