Dear Parents

I write to inform you of the news that Mr Boyse, Head of Sixth Form, has taken the decision to retire from teaching with effect from the end of this term.

Mr Boyse was appointed as Head of Sixth Form in September 2000 and throughout his time here he has worked tirelessly in support of the boys in Sixth Form. Over that time the Sixth has grown in size and stature with high percentages of our boys progressing successfully to university or into the field of work. He also saw the move of the Sixth Form, in 2002, to its current buildings. The success of the Sixth Form is reflected in the high percentage of boys choosing to move into the Sixth Form from Syntax.

Mr Boyse has also undertaken whole school roles as Assistant Head as well as having positive working relationships with the Ursuline Sixth Form team and indeed with other local Sixth Forms over the years. This included providing guidance and support to Raynes Park High School when they were opening their Sixth Form.

He will be sorely missed by staff and pupils and I am certain that the hundreds, if not thousands, of boys who have passed through his care would join with you and all at the College to thank him for his commitment, enthusiasm and the example that he has set as a man for others. I would also like to take the opportunity to wish Mr Boyse all the very best in his new ventures.

We are advertising for a replacement for Mr Boyse this week with a proposed start date of Easter 2019. For the Spring Term Mr Murphy will be taking on the responsibility of leading the Sixth Form and will be supported by the current Sixth Form team. Other aspects of Mr Boyse's current responsibilities are being taken on by other members of the Senior Leadership Team.
