



The Wimbledon College Great War memorial – College Chapel

One of the ways we intend to mark the centenary of the end of the First World War is to refurbish the Memorial in the Chapel. We are going to apply gold leaf to the names of those who died during the war. [As the wood has darkened it has become more difficult to read the names]. It is intended that the work will be completed by the end of 2017, in preparation for the Anniversary.

The cost of the work breaks down to £60 for each name and I am proposing that members of the school community may choose to sponsor a name.
