<u>Addendum</u>

On the advice of the Education Commission of the Archdiocese of Southwark the governing body of Wimbledon College has agreed the following statement in order to clarify how its faith-based oversubscription criteria will be interpreted in light of the suspension of the obligation to attend Sunday Mass between 18th March 2020 and 4th June 2022.

As of the 5th June 2022, Pentecost, the Bishops of England and Wales reinstated the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. Parents applying for a place at Wimbledon College, under a faith-based criteria will need to complete a Supplementary Information Form and Religious Practice and Priest's Reference Form. Evidence of practice will be measured by frequency of attendance at Mass as validated by either a priest or minister, as was the case prior to 18th March 2020. These arrangements apply to the admissions round for 2023 and subsequent rounds
