Privacy Notice for Guest Internet Users

This privacy notice describes how Wimbledon College collects and uses personal information in accordance with the UK General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018.

Who is responsible for your data?

Wimbledon College is the “data controller.” This means we are responsible for deciding how we hold and use personal information about you.

What information do we collect?

When you use our guest Wi-Fi, we may collect:

- Device information (such as MAC address, IP address)
- Usage logs (websites visited, connection times, bandwidth usage)
- Any information you provide when signing the Acceptable Use Agreement

Why do we collect this information?

We collect this information to:

- Ensure the security and integrity of our network
- Monitor usage for safeguarding and legal compliance
- Comply with our legal obligations as an educational institution

How will your information be used?

- Your internet usage may be monitored and logged for security and safeguarding purposes.
- Data will only be accessed by authorised staff and will not be shared with third parties except where required by law.

How long will we keep your information?

Usage logs are retained for a limited period in accordance with our data retention policy and deleted when no longer required.

Your rights
