

Uniform

Sixth Form pupils are not required to wear the school uniform. You are, however, expected to follow the dress code. Dress and appearance are to be in keeping with the formality of school life. Students not meeting the correct dress code will be sent home to rectify the situation.

- Sixth Form pupils are required to wear a suit or formal jacket and trousers.
- Shirts are to be formal, plain or striped in sober colours, tucked in and the top button done up.
- The Sixth Form tie is to be worn and must be clearly visible.
- Shoes should be formal and suitable for wearing with a suit or jacket and tie.
- Trainers, canvas shoes and boat shoes are not appropriate.
- Hair should be clean and tidy.
- Boys are to be clean-shaven.
- Jewellery is not to be worn.
